## What can I do now?

Please come speak with the International Studies Coordinator for the College of Education about this internship program. You are also encouraged to get to know the COE faculty. You will need two reference letters for this application. Please take the OGET prior to your application's due date and start researching your potential destination.

## What is the Committee looking for in candidates?

Students abroad are ambassadors of the COE and of OSU, and are therefore expected to have strong academic performances but to also be professional, mature, and responsible. The International Student Teaching Committee will consider your holistic application. You do not need to have previous international experience.

## What happens after I'm accepted?

During the semester, you will be:

- Required to attend safety, travel, and cultural orientations
- Required to research your destination and host country
- Informed of visa requirements or additional travel documents applicable to your site
- Provided with the opportunity to contact former interns
- Notified of your placement/ cooperating teacher and flight options (the timing of placements can vary)
- Invited to a parent/faculty meet and greet to which former international interns are invited
